**Intramural Sports Code of Conduct**

The purpose of this code is to insure safe and enjoyable recreational participation while encouraging individuals to exercise good sportsmanship. The Code of Conduct as stated below will govern all intramural play:

**Rules of Personal Conduct**

Any person, who commits, attempts to commit, incites or aids others in committing any of the following acts of misconduct shall be subject to disciplinary procedures by the Department of Intramurals. **Clarification: Team Captains are responsible for the conduct of their players and therefore are responsible to the same disciplinary actions as their players.**

- a. Physical conduct in a threatening manner (verbal or physical intimidation) toward officials, timers, supervisors, and players will result in immediate suspension from intramural sports and may result in permanent suspension.
- b. Game ejection results in suspension from the team's next scheduled contest. The second ejection will result in the player being indefinitely suspended from any further competition pending a hearing before the intramural board that will be held within seven days after the ejection.
- c. Any player that has been ejected and does not leave the playing area (gym, field, etc.) immediately will result in a forfeit for his/her team and result in a two game suspension.
- d. The Director of Intramurals reserves the right to bar any player or team from further competition for any un-sportsmanlike act.
- e. Only the captain may address an official on matters of interpretation and for information while respecting the game official's decision.

**Alcohol Policy**

Drinking alcohol is not allowed while participating in intramurals. Drinking alcohol by players and/or spectators will result in a forfeit for your team. All intramural officials are allowed to assess a team a forfeit for violating this alcohol policy.

**Vandalism**

Deliberate destruction of Rensselaer property and equipment; public property; or personal property of individuals will not be tolerated. All incidents will be reported to Public Safety and any other proper authorities.
