

RENSELAER INTRAMURAL 3-ON-3 BASKETBALL RULES

Each match will consist of a maximum of three (3) games. The first team that wins two (2) out of three (3) games wins the match. The first team to 21 points wins. (Games do NOT have to be won by two (2) points as time is a limiting factor).

PLAYING RULES

Collegiate Basketball rules will govern play, with the following exceptions:

1. All fouls will be called by the fouled person.
2. Winner's out after a basket is scored. The ball must be taken out near half-court and must be checked by a defensive player before it can be put into play.
3. After a defensive rebound, the ball must be taken past the 3-point line.
4. A regulation shot counts as 2 points while a shot beyond the arc will count as 3 points.
5. After each game the losing team will take the ball out first in the next game.

REPORTING SCORES

Winning team captains must report scores to the Coordinator within 24 hours of the scheduled game. Unreported scores will be recorded as a loss for both teams.
