RPI HOSTS HOLIDAY TOURNAMENT:

The Engineers host the 60th Annual Rensselaer Holiday Tournament - the oldest college hockey holiday tournament in the nation ... Participating in the event along with #17 RPI (5-3-3; 2-2-0 ECAC Hockey) are Connecticut (3-4-3; 3-3-1 Atlantic Hockey), Alabama-Huntsville (1-10-1) and Bowling Green (2-8-0; 5-9-0 CCHA).

ALL-TIME VS. CONNECTICUT:

Rensselaer leads the all-time series against the Huskies, 2-0-2 ... The Engineers won the first meeting, 6-5 in overtime, on January 18, 1930, in Troy ... The next two meetings ended in draws ... RPI captured the victory in the last matchup, 4-1, on October 16, 2004, at the Houston Field House.

AT HOME: Three of the four games between RPI and UConn have been played in Troy ... The lone exception was a game in Omaha.

APPERT MISSING:

Rensselaer head coach Seth Appert is not allowed to coach the Engineers in tonight's game against Connecticut due to an ECAC Hockey imposed suspension ... Appert was reprimanded for his actions following RPI's game on November 12 at Union ... He will be behind the bench for Saturday's contest.

ALL-TIME VS. ALABAMA-HUNTSVILLE:

RPI leads the all-time series with the Chargers, 3-0-1 ... The Engineers won the inaugural meeting, 6-3, on November 30, 1991, in Huntsville ... The last matchup between the two schools, January 16, 1993, here at the Field House, ended in a 5-5 tie.

HEADING TO HUNTSVILLE:

Regardless of whether Rensselaer and Alabama-Huntsville meet in this tournament, the two schools face each other on December 30-31 in Huntsville.

RPI VS. BOWLING GREEN

ALL-TIME: The Engineers are 8-8-1

against the Falcons, dating back to their first-ever meeting on January 2, 1970 ... RPI won the inaugural contest, 5-4, in Troy ... The most recent games came in January 2002, a Rensselaer win and tie.

AT HOME: The Engineers hold a 6-1-1 advantage over the Falcons at the Field House.

HOLIDAY TOURNAMENT WINNERS:

Of the four teams competing in this year's tournament, Rensselaer is the only winner of the event, most recently capturing the 2001-02 championship ... Bowling Green, which is 2-1-0 in the event, nor Alabama-Huntsville has never won the tournament, while Connecticut has never participated.

TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONS: RPI has won its own tournament 16 times.

RECENT TOURNAMENT HISTORY:

The Engineers suffered an overtime loss, 5-4, to Union in last year's championship game ... RPI scored with one second remaining in the third period to send the game into the extra session, but Union senior Jason Walters scored at 3:39 of the extra frame.

ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAMS:

Rensselaer senior forward Tyler Helfrich has been named to the All-Tournament team once (2007-08), while classmate Chase Polacek has been honored twice (2007-08 & 2009-10).

2010-11 RENSSELAER MEN'S HOCKEY GAME NOTES

RPI IN IT'S OWN TOURNAMENT:

Nine different players have tallied a point or more in holiday tournament play, including seven with multiple points ... Senior **Chase Polacek** leads the team with two goals and five assists, while **Tyler Helfrich** has two goals and three assists ... Junior **Allen York** (0-2-0) stopped 16 shots in last year's 5-4 overtime loss to Union.

NATIONAL LEADER: Rensselaer has the top scoring defense in the nation, averaging 1.82 goals against per game.

LEADING THE ENGINEERS: Senior forward **Chase Polacek** has a team-high 14 points in 11 games ... He has scored five goals, which is also first on the team, with nine assists ... Classmate **Tyler Helfrich** has four goals and eight assists, while sophomore defenseman **Nick Bailen** has 12 points on four goals and eight assists.

IN GOAL: Junior **Allen York** (5-3-3) has a 1.78 goals against average and a .931 save percentage in 674:57 ... Eleven of the 20 goals he has allowed have come with RPI shorthanded.

SPECIAL TEAMS: The Engineers have connected on 11 of 65 power play chances for a success rate of 16.9% ... They are successful on 82.5% (52 of 63) of their penalty killing situations.

PACING THE HUSKIES: Connecticut, which snapped a four-game winless streak (0-3-1) with a win last Saturday, is led in scoring by freshman Cole Schneider (3 goals, 6 assists), who has nine points ... Sophomores Sean Ambrosie (3 goals, 5 assists) and Miles Winter (2 goals, 6 assists) each have eight points ... In goal, sophomore Garrett Bartus (3-4-3) has a 3.51 goals against average with a .898 save percentage ... The Huskies are coached by Bruce Marshall, who is in his 23rd season.

FALCONS LEADERS: Sophomore forward Jordan Samuels-Thomas (3 goals, 7 assists) leads Bowling Green with 10 points ... Classmate Marc Rodriguez (4 goals, 4 assists) and freshman Camden Wojtala (2 goals, 6 assists) have eight points apiece ... Two netminders have split time in goal ... Senior Nick Eno (3-4-0) has a 3.17 goals against average with a .889 save percentage, while sophomore Andrew Hammond (2-5-0) has a 3.43 goals against average with an .899 save percentage ... The Falcons, who are coached by first-year mentor Chris Bergeron, enter the tournament having lost three straight.

FORMER FALCON: Rensselaer defenseman Nick Bailen spent the 2008-09 academic year at Bowling Green, where he tallied six goals and 10 assists in 37 games ... Three of his markers came on the power play ... Bailen left BGSU to play in the USHL before coming to RPI.

LEADING ALABAMA-HUNTSVILLE: The Chargers, who play an independent schedule, are led offensively by sophomore Keenan Desmet (4 goals, 4 assists) with eight points ... Junior Tom Durnie and senior Matt Baxter (1 goal, 6 assists each) are tied with seven points ... Freshman Clarke Saunders (1-7-0) has seen the majority of time between the pipes, posting a 4.29 goals against average and a .875 save percentage ... Alabama-Huntsville, which is on a 10-game winless streak (0-9-1) has been idle since November 13 ... Chris Luongo is in his first year behind the bench for UAH.

KOUDYS CONNECTION: RPI freshman defenseman **Patrick Koudys** is a cousin of Alabama-Huntsville senior forward Joey Koudys ... This is the second time this season Patrick has played against a cousin ... Joey's brother, Dan, is a sophomore at Bentley ... Rensselaer defeated the Falcons, 4-1, on October 16.

NATIONAL TOP 20: Sophomore **Nick Bailen** is second nationally in points per game by a defenseman with an average of 1.09 ... Junior **Allen York** is seventh nationally in goals against average (1.79) and 11th in save percentage (.931) ... Freshman forward **Brock Higgs** is sixth in game-winning goals with two.

OTHERS RANKED: Alabama-Huntsville junior forward Jamie Easton is 20th in the nation in power play goals with three ... Connecticut freshman forward Cole Schneider is 18th in points per game by a rookie, averaging 16.3.

HIGH PIMS: Three of the four teams in the field are ranked in the top 12 nationally in penalty minutes per game ... Alabama-Huntsville is fourth (18.2 per game), Bowling Green is seventh (17.6) and UConn is 12th (16.3) ... Rensselaer is 34th, averaging 13.5 penalty minutes per contest.

NATIONAL TITLES: RPI and Bowling Green have both won NCAA Championships ... The Engineers captured the 1954 and 1985 titles ... The Falcons were champions in 1984.

STAYING HOT: Sophomore defenseman **Nick Bailen** has eight points (3 goals, 5 assists) in his last six games ... Senior forward **Tyler Helfrich** has 12 points (4 goals, 8 assists) in his last 10 games.

MULTIPLE POINTS: Senior forward **Chase Polacek** has multiple points (2 goals, 4 assists) in three of his last five games.

GAME GOALIE: Junior **Allen York** has played every game in goal for the Engineers this season.

POLACEK CLIMBING: Senior **Chase Polacek** has 125 career points (49 goals, 74 assists) and ranks 38th in school history ... **Wayne Clark '95**, who had 126 career points (62 goals, 64 assists) is 37th.

IN NOVEMBER: Rensselaer is 2-2-0 in the month of November ... Sophomore defenseman **Nick Bailen** has a team-best five points (2 goals, 3 assists), while senior **Chase Polacek** (2 goals, 2 assists) has four ... **Allen York** is 2-2-0 in goal with a 1.75 goals against average and a .924 save percentage ... HEAD COACH SETH APPERT

Seth Appert is in his fifth season as the head coach of the men's hockey program, having led Rensselaer to a 49-85-18 record while playing one of the toughest schedules in the nation since taking over prior to the 2006-07 season.

Last season was Appert's most successful to date at Rensselaer, as he led the Engineers to an 18-17-4 overall record, including a 10-9-3 mark in ECAC Hockey play. RPI earned home-ice advantage in the First Round of the ECACH Playoffs for the first time since 2005-06. 10 players recorded 10 or more points, while eight notched 15 or more.

Chase Polacek was selected as one of the Final 10 players up for the prestigious Hobey Baker Award, while earning ECAC Hockey Player of the Year honors. Freshman Jerry D'Amigo was named the league's Rookie of the Year, while classmate Brandon Pirri joined him on the All-Rookie Team. Sophomore netminder Allen York was a finalist for Goaltender of the Year in ECAC Hockey.

In 2008-09, Appert's Engineers swept Dartmouth in the ECAC Hockey Playoffs on their way to the quarterfinals, where they were eliminated in a decisive third game. The team's top four scorers were either freshman or sophomores and one of those freshman players, Patrick Cullen, was named to ECAC Hockey's All-Rookie Team. Two of RPI's incoming recruits – Brandon Pirri and Jerry D'Amigo – were selected in the NHL Draft by Chicago and Toronto, respectively.

Highlights during Appert's first two seasons include leading the Engineers to back-to-back titles in the Governor's Cup Tournament – Rensselaer's first championships of any kind since 1998 – and garnering points against six nationally-ranked opponents. RPI has had a nationally-ranked recruiting class and also enjoyed numerous stints in the national polls, including eight straight weeks in 2007-08.

Individually, Rensselaer student-athletes have earned All-League and All-Rookie status as well as having a Student-Athlete of the Year Award finalist and a Hockey Humanitarian Award finalist.

Specifically in Appert's first season, the Engineers captured the inaugural Governor's Cup Championship and won at nationally-ranked Denver – Appert's first career win, which came against his previous employer. Individually, senior defenseman Jake Luthi earned All-League honors while classmate Kirk MacDonald, a forward, garnered the USCHO.com's Unsung Hero Award, as well as several national community service honors.

In 2007-08, Rensselaer's recruiting class was nationally-ranked, the Engineers captured the Governor's Cup and enjoyed a long stint, senior forward Andrew Lord was a finalist for the ECAC Hockey Scholar-Athlete Award and freshman forward Chase Polacek was named to the ECAC Hockey All-Rookie Team.

In addition to his position at RPI, Appert served as an assistant coach for the 2007 U.S. Under-18 Select Team that competed in the Memorial of Ivan Hlinka Tournament and as the head coach of the team in 2008. He was also a coach in the 2008 NCAA Pontiac Skills Challenge and was named president of the American Hockey Coaches Association (AHCA), which has almost 1,400 members.

He is currently in his third year of the three-year term as AHCA President.

During the summer of 2007, Appert signed a contract extension through 2011-12.

"In just one year Seth has become an important member of the Rensselaer community with a very positive influence across the campus," said President Shirley Ann Jackson upon the announcement of the extension. "He has shown a willingness to meet challenges head on and a determination to succeed. These are attributes that will continue to shape outstanding young men, while generating a great deal of excitement and increasing levels of success on the ice."

"Seth's ambition and enthusiasm fit perfectly for Rensselaer," said Vice President of Student Life Eddie Ade Knowles. "When looking at the outstanding young men he

recruits, as well as the eagerness to play the best teams in the country, there is no doubt we will again become one of the nation's elite programs. I look forward to working with him for many years to come."

"I am very thankful to President Jackson and Dr. Knowles for their continued support of our program and the vision and leadership they provide for our university," said Appert. "We have set a strong foundation for future success and we will continue to move this program forward with the support from the RPI campus community and our terrific fans in the Capital Region. This is our home and my wife and I are excited about raising our kids here while bringing RPI hockey back to national prominence."

Appert, the 12th head men's hockey coach in the storied program's history, spent nine seasons as an assistant coach at Denver, where he was responsible for recruiting, on-ice coaching, video breakdown and game analysis work. He also played a big role in the development of the Pioneers' goaltenders.

A collegiate netminder at Ferris State University, Appert individually coached one All-America, two All-Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) honorees, two WCHA Playoff Most Valuable Players and two Frozen Four Most Outstanding Players at Denver.

Three of his goaltenders were draft picks of the National Hockey League, including one Hobey Baker Award finalist. All three of those netminders have played in the NHL in recent years.

Appert, who was born August 9, 1974, helped Denver sign numerous nationally-ranked recruiting classes during his nine-year tenure with the Pioneers. Among those he coached or recruited at Denver were the 2006 Hobey Baker Award winner, eight All-Americans, a WCHA Player of the Year, 22 All-WCHA picks, three WCHA Defensive Players of the Year, two WCHA Student-Athletes of the Year and 17 NHL draft picks. The Pioneers averaged over 23 wins per year during his tenure as an assistant coach and captured two NCAA National Championships, three WCHA playoff championships and two WCHA regular-season titles.

A four-year letterwinner at Ferris State from 1992-96, Appert and his wife, Jill, have two daughters, Addison, who is five, and Campbell, who was born in June 2007.
