LEADING THE ENGINEERS: Senior forward Chase Polacek has a team-high 23 points in 16 games ... He has eight goals with a team-high 15 assists ... Sophomore defenseman Nick Bailen is second with 19 points on seven goals and 12 assists

... Senior Tyler Helfrich is third with a team-best nine goals and eight assists for 17 points ... Polacek has the most penalty minutes on the team with 22.

IN GOAL: Junior Allen York has played 93.0% of the games, posting an 8-4-3 record ... He has a 1.84 goals against average and a .930 save percentage in 913:24.

SPECIAL TEAMS: The Engineers have connected on 17 of 93 power play chances for a success rate of 18.3% ... They are successful on 83.0% (73 of 88) of their penalty killing situations.

RPI VS. U.S. DEVELOPMENT TEAMS: The Engineers own an 0-1-0 record against teams in the USA Hockey National Development Programs ... That contest, against the U.S. Under-18 Team, was played on Oct. 12, 2008 - a 5-4 loss for the Engineers.

INDIVIDUAL VS. U.S. TEAMS: Seven current Rensselaer players recorded points against the U.S. Under-18 Team in 2008 ... Leading the way were Chase Polacek and Josh Rabbani, who each had a goal and an assist ... Alex Angers-Goulet and Bryan Brutlag had the other two tallies, while Tyler Helfrich, Mike Bergin and Allen York all had an assist.

ronto Maple Leafs in the summer following his rookie year at Rensselaer ... During the 2009-10 season with the Engineers, D'Amigo played in 35 games, tallying 10 goals and 24 assists for 34 points ... He was third on the team in points, second in assists and fourth in goals ... D'Amigo was the 2010 ECAC Hockey Rookie of the Year and a Freshman All-America by Inside College Hockey.com ... He currently plays for the Toronto Marlies of the AHL.

BACK AGAIN: Seven of the current members of the National Junior Team played against Rensselaer during the match-up in 2008 at the Houston Field House ... Among them are Ryan Bourque, Chris Brown, former Engineers' standout **Jerry D'Amigo**, Jeremy Morin, Kyle Palmieri, John Ramage and Drew Shore ... Palmieri - a current member of the AHL's Syracuse Crunch - had a goal and an assist, while Morin also had a goal ... Bourque and Brown notched two assists apiece, while D'Amigo also had a helper.

OCTOBER 12, 2008: Five different players scored goals, including three on the power play, and the U.S. Under-18 Team held off Rensselaer, 5-4, in an exhibition game ... Facing a 4-1 deficit late in the second period, Rensselaer pulled to within two goals with 31 seconds left on a **Bryan Brutlag** tally ... RPI's **Josh Rabbani** cut the deficit further to open the third, but Jeremy Morin converted on a 2-on-1 under two minutes later for a 5-3 U.S. lead ... **Chase Polacek** tallied mid-way through the final period, but RPI could not get any closer ... Brandon Maxwell finished with 21 saves for the U.S. team, while **Allen York** stopped 35 shots for the Engineers, including 14 in the first and third periods.

RPI LAST WEEKEND: The Engineers hosted #7 Boston University last weekend, earning a 4-1 victory ... Junior **Allen York** stopped 28 of 29 shots and the Engineers scored all four tallies on special teams ... RPI jumped out to a 2-0 lead after the opening period as senior **Joel Malchuk** scored short-handed and classmate **Tyler Helfrich** converted with an extra-man advantage ... **Chase Polacek** made it a 3-0 margin in the middle stanza, but BU's Wade Megan cut the deficit mid-way through the frame to make it a two-goal game ... Senior **Bryan Brutlag** added an insurance goal in the final period.

named the Inside College Hockey (INCH) Player of the Week after scoring a goal and two assists, while York earned ECAC Hockey Goaltender of the Week honors following his 28 save performance against the Terriers.

NATIONAL TOP 20: Entering today's action, Rensselaer sophomore **Nick Bailen** is third nationally in points per game by a defenseman with an average of 1.19 (19 points in 16 games) ... Senior **Chase Polacek** is 12th in points per game with an average of 1.44 (23 points in 16 games) and 14th in assists with 0.94 (15 assists) ... Classmate **Joel Malchuk** is currently second in the country in shorthanded goals (2), while **Allen York**, a junior, ranks fifth nationally in save percentage (.930) and sixth in goals against average (1.84).

AMONG TEAM LEADERS: As a team the Engineers are fifth in the nation in goals allowed per game, allowing 2.12 goals per contest.

STAYING HOT: Sophomore defenseman **Nick Bailen** has 15 points (6 goals, 9 assists) in his last 11 games ... Senior forward **Tyler Helfrich** has 17 points (9 goals, 8 assists) in his last 14 games, while classmate **Chase Polacek** has 12 points (3 goals, 9 assists) in his last six games ... Seven of those points (1 goal, 6 assists) have come in Polacek's last two contests.

POLACEK CLIMBING: With 135 career points (52 goals, 83 assists), including a goal and two assists in Saturday's win against Boston University, senior **Chase Polacek** is tied for 32nd in school history in points, alongside **Trevor Kaye '62** (59 goals, 76 assists) ... He is two points from joining **Mo Mosco '55** (61 goals, 76 assists) and **Richard Scammell '69** (69 goals, 68 assists) in 30th.

IN THE DAYTIME: Today's contest marks Rensselaer's fifth day game this season ...

The Engineers are 3-0-1 in such contests, having defeated Bentley (3-0), tying Union (3-3) and beating Brown (6-2) and Boston University (4-1) ... The Engineers have five more day games after this one, including three at home.

FIVE OF SIX: Rensselaer has won five of its last six games.

UNBEATEN AT HOME: The Engineers are 7-0-0 at the Houston Field House this season.

NON-LEAGUE GAMES: RPI is 6-1-3 in non-league games in 2010-11.

NATIONAL LISTING: RPI is ranked 14th in the nation in both the USCHO.com Poll and the USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine Polls ... The Engineers are 12th in the latest INCH Power Ratings.

MALCHUK RETURNS: Senior **Joel Malchuk** returned to the lineup against Boston University after missing the last three games due to injury ... He scored RPI's first goal - shorthanded - against the Terriers.

WELCOME BACK LEE: Sophomore **C.J. Lee** also returned to the ice in Saturday's game with the Terriers ... He had an assist after missing the previous three games.

OUT OF THE LINEUP: Rensselaer played last weekend's game without two regulars, both of whom were injured ... They were senior captain **John Kennedy**, a defenseman and sophomore forward **Marty O'Grady** ... Their status for this weekend is unknown.
