RIVARLY RENEWED III: For the third time this season, the Engineers face their biggest rival, #14 Union ... Saturday's game is an ECAC Hockey contest that begins at 7pm.

RIVARLY RENEWED II: The Engineers faced Union in a non-league contest in Lake Placid on December 10 ... The Dutchmen won that game, 5-2.

RIVARLY RENEWED I: RPI and the Dutchmen played an ECAC Hockey game on November 15 in Troy ... Union skated to a 5-1 victory in that game.

FOLLOWING THE ACTION: All RPI men's hockey games can be heard live on WRPI, 91.5 FM, and on the Internet on wrpi.org ... Live statistics are available at rpiathletics.com/livestats.



OFFICIALS: The referees for the game are Harry Dumas and Scott Whittemore ... The linesmen are Ryan Knapp and Todd Whittemore.

ALL-TIME VS UNION: Rensselaer owns a 45-25-10 record against Union ... The 80 games rank eighth against any one opponent for RPI and the 45 wins are sixth most.

DECEMBER 10, 2011: Union scored the game's final three goals, including two late in the second period, to pull away from the Engineers, 5-2 in the Festivus Faceoff in Lake Placid ... Five different players scored for the Dutchmen, who got 23 saves from Troy Grosenick ... **C.J. Lee** and **Mark McGowan** both scored their first goals for Rensselaer, which got 27 saves from junior **Bryce Merriam** ... RPI failed to score on five power play opportunities, while Union was 1 for 9.

NOVEMBER 15, 2011: Sophomore Daniel Carr had a hat trick with an assist and classmate Josh Jooris notched three assists as Union

defeated the Engineers, 5-1 ... RPI jumped out to a quick lead on a power play goal by **Nick Bailen**, but the Dutchmen scored twice in each of the first two periods and once in the third ... Troy Grosenick made 21 saves in the victory, while **Bryce Merriam** stopped 25 shots for Rensselaer.

LAST SEASON: RPI split the series against the Dutchmen in 2010-11, falling 2-1 in Schenectady before beating Union, 4-3 in overtime the following day - Black Saturday ... The two teams tied, 3-3 in a non-league game in Lake Placid in late October.

LAST 12: The Engineers are 2-8-2 against Union over the last 12 meetings.

APPERT IN CHARGE: RPI head coach **Seth Appert** has a 4-12-3 coaching record against the Dutchmen.

CLOSE CONTESTS: Eleven of the last 16 games between Rensselaer and Union have been decided by one goal or fewer ... Six of those games have gone to overtime with both teams winning twice and two ties ... All three games last season were close, with a tie and each team winning by a goal.

OCTOBER 30, 2010: In their first meeting last year, the Engineers and Dutchmen skated to a 3-3 tie in a non-league game in Lake Placid ... Union's Mat Bodie scored with just 30 seconds remaining in regulation to force overtime ... Both goaltenders were

solid as RPI's **Allen York** finished with 17 stops, while Keith Kincaid made 25 saves ... The Dutchmen jumped out to the 2-0 advantage in the opening frame but RPI's **Nick Bailen** cut the deficit in the second period on a wrist shot from the top of the slot ... The Engineers took the lead with quick goals by **CJ Lee** and **Tyler Helfrich** in the third period ... Union went 2 for 3 on the power play, while the Engineers were 0 for 3 with the man-advantage.

NOVEMBER 12, 2010: Keith Kinkaid stopped 19 of 20 shots and Jeremy Welsh notched a goal and an assist to lead Union to a 2-1 victory over the Engineers at Messa Rink ... Daniel Carr also scored for the Dutchmen, who were 2 for 6 on the power play ... **Allen York** stopped 18 shots for the Engineers, who got its goal from defenseman **Nick Bailen**.

NOVEMBER 13, 2010: Nick Bailen recorded a goal and two assists, including the game-winning tally midway through overtime, to lift Rensselaer to a come-from-behind, 4-3 victory over Union on Black Saturday at the Houston Field House ... With a 5-on-3 advantage in the extra frame, Bailen one-timed a shot off the left post and in at the 2:56 mark ... The Engineers came back to tie the game twice in the final stanza, including an equalizing tally by **Marty O'Grady** with 0.2 seconds on the clock ... The goal, which tied the score at 3-3, came on the power-play and with an extra attacker ... **Allen York** finished with 20 saves for RPI, while Keith Kinkaid made 31 stops for Union, which got a goal and an assist from Matt Hatch.

IN LEAGUE PLAY: The Engineers are 18-17-6 against Union in ECAC Hockey play ... The first conference game between the two came on December 27, 1991 - a 6-4 RPI victory in Troy.

IN EXTRA TIME: Rensselaer is 4-5-9 all-time in overtime games against Union.

RPI ON TUESDAY NIGHT: Junior **C.J. Lee** had a goal and an assist, **Curtis Leonard** scored his first career goal and **Joel Malchuk** tallied an empty net goal as the Engineers defeated American International in their final non-league game of the regular season ... RPI held a 2-0 lead late in the third period before the Yellow Jackets pulled to within one at 17:03 ... Junior **Bryce Merriam** made 15 saves for Rensselaer, which outshot AIC, 37-16 ... Ben Meisner made 34 saves in defeat.

RPI on Tuesday tied the fewest given up in a game this season ... The Engineers also held Army to 16 shots on goal (Dec. 30).

FIRST CAREER GOAL: Freshman defenseman **Curtis Leonard** scored his first collegiate goal on Tuesday against AIC on a slapshot from the right point.

FIRST EMPTY NET GOAL: Rensselaer scored its first empty net goal of the season on Tuesday night ... The Engineers have allowed nine such goals.

POINT STREAKS: Junior defenseman **Nick Bailen** (5 assists) and junior forward **Marty O'Grady** (4 assists) both have four-game assist streaks.

STREAK SNAPPED: Entering Tuesday's game, sophomore forward **Brock Higgs** had a six-game point streak (1 goal, 6 assists) and a point in seven of eight games (1 goal, 8 assists) ... He was held off the scoresheet by AIC.

PERFECT PK: The Engineers were 6 for 6 on the penalty kill against American International, marking the first time in six games they did not allow a power play goal.

WITHOUT GOULET: Senior forward **Alex Angers-Goulet** sat out Tuesday's game with a leg injury ... It was the first game he missed this season ... His status for Saturday is unknown.

NON-LEAGUE COMPLETE: The Engineers finished 3-9-0 in non-conference regular season contests ... They were 1-3-0 against the WCHA, 0-3-0 versus the CCHA, 2-1-0 against Atlantic Hockey, 0-1-0 versus ECAC Hockey and 0-1-0 against Hockey East.

NON-LEAGUE LEADERS: Sophomore **Brock Higgs** had seven points (1 goal, 6 assists) in seven non-league games to lead the

Engineers ... **Nick Bailen** (2 goals, 3 assists) had five points, while freshman **Ryan Haggerty** (2 goals, 2 assists) tallied four against non-conference opposition ... **Bryce Merriam** played eight games, going 2-6-0 with a 2.54 goals against average and .905 save percentage ... **Scott Diebold** is 1-3-0 with a 2.77 average and an .884 percentage.

RENSSELAER TO DATE: Rensselaer averages 1.52 goals on 25.5 shots per game with 14.7 penalty minutes per contest ... The Engineers allow 3.05 goals and 26.7 shots per game ... The opposition averages 13.8 PIMs.

OFFENSIVE LEADERS: Junior **Nick Bailen** (3 goals, 10 assists), a defenseman, is RPI's leading scorer with 13 points ... Sophomore **Brock Higgs** (1 goal, 10 assists), a forward, is second with 11, followed by freshman forward **Ryan Haggerty** (team-high 5 goals, 4 assists) ... Bailen has played all 21 games, while Higgs and Haggerty have suited up for 16 and 18, respectively.

IN GOAL: Junior **Bryce Merriam** and freshman **Scott Diebold** have been sharing time in net lately, alternating starts over the last nine games ... On the season Merriam is 3-12-0 with a 2.66 goals against average and an .901 save percentage ... **Diebold** is 1-4-1 with a 2.65 average and a .900 percentage ... Merriam and Diebold have one shutout each.

SPECIAL TEAMS: The Engineers are 12 for 97 (12.4%) on the power play ... RPI is 85 for 107 (84.9%) when shorthanded – good enough for 13th in the nation – with one goal for (**Alex Angers-Goulet**).

UPCOMING: Rensselaer continues this three-game road trip next weekend when it travels to Brown and Yale next Friday and Saturday ... Both games begin at 7pm.
